

### Composer's origin country



Composer's living country Where do you live today?


What is your education background?

## Are you able to live by composing or do you need another source of income?








Do you think differentiating male composer and female composer is relevant?

"we keep seeing more male students and professors in composition and more male composers' works played in concerts"

"actions to support women in art are of the greatest importance."



"Advertising gender over a musical work, can very likely downgrade a female composer's work and it may even be insulting in the end."

"As a composer, at least, I lose interest in a project if I know I am invited somewhere on the basis of my gender alone, and not because my music is good."

"I don't think it's relevant to differentiate between composers on the basis of any gender, racial or any other criterion other than the musical criterion. [...] musical composition thrives on subjectivity, and that's a good thing!"






Do you think gender identity plays a role in the development of a composer's career?

"Gender is everywhere, there are no gender neutral careers."






# Do you prefer to work with men or women?
